<sup>31</sup> “The days are coming,” declares the LORD,  
“when I will make a new covenant  
with the people of Israel  
and with the people of Judah.

<sup>32</sup> It will not be like the covenant  
I made with their ancestors  
when I took them by the hand  
to lead them out of Egypt,  
because they broke my covenant,  
though I was a husband to<sup>[a]</sup> them,<sup>[b]</sup>”  
declares the LORD.

<sup>33</sup> “This is the covenant I will make with the people of Israel  
after that time,” declares the LORD.  
“I will put my law in their minds  
and write it on their hearts.

**Jesus Predicts His Death**

<sup>20</sup> Now there were some Greeks among those who went up to worship  
at the festival. <sup>21</sup> They came to Philip, who was from Bethsaida in Galilee,  
with a request. “Sir,” they said, “we would like to see Jesus.”

<sup>22</sup> Philip went to tell Andrew;  
Andrew and Philip in turn told Jesus.

<sup>23</sup> Jesus replied, “The hour has come for the Son of Man to be glorified. <sup>24</sup> Very truly I tell you, unless a kernel of wheat falls to the ground and dies, it remains only a single seed. But if it dies, it produces many seeds. <sup>25</sup> Anyone who loves their life will lose it, while anyone who hates their life in this world will keep it for eternal life.

<sup>26</sup> Whoever serves me must follow me; and where I am, my servant also will be.

My Father will honour the one who serves me.

<sup>27</sup> “Now my soul is troubled, and what shall I say? ‘Father, save me from this hour’? No, it was for this very reason I came to this hour.
